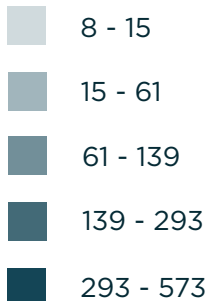
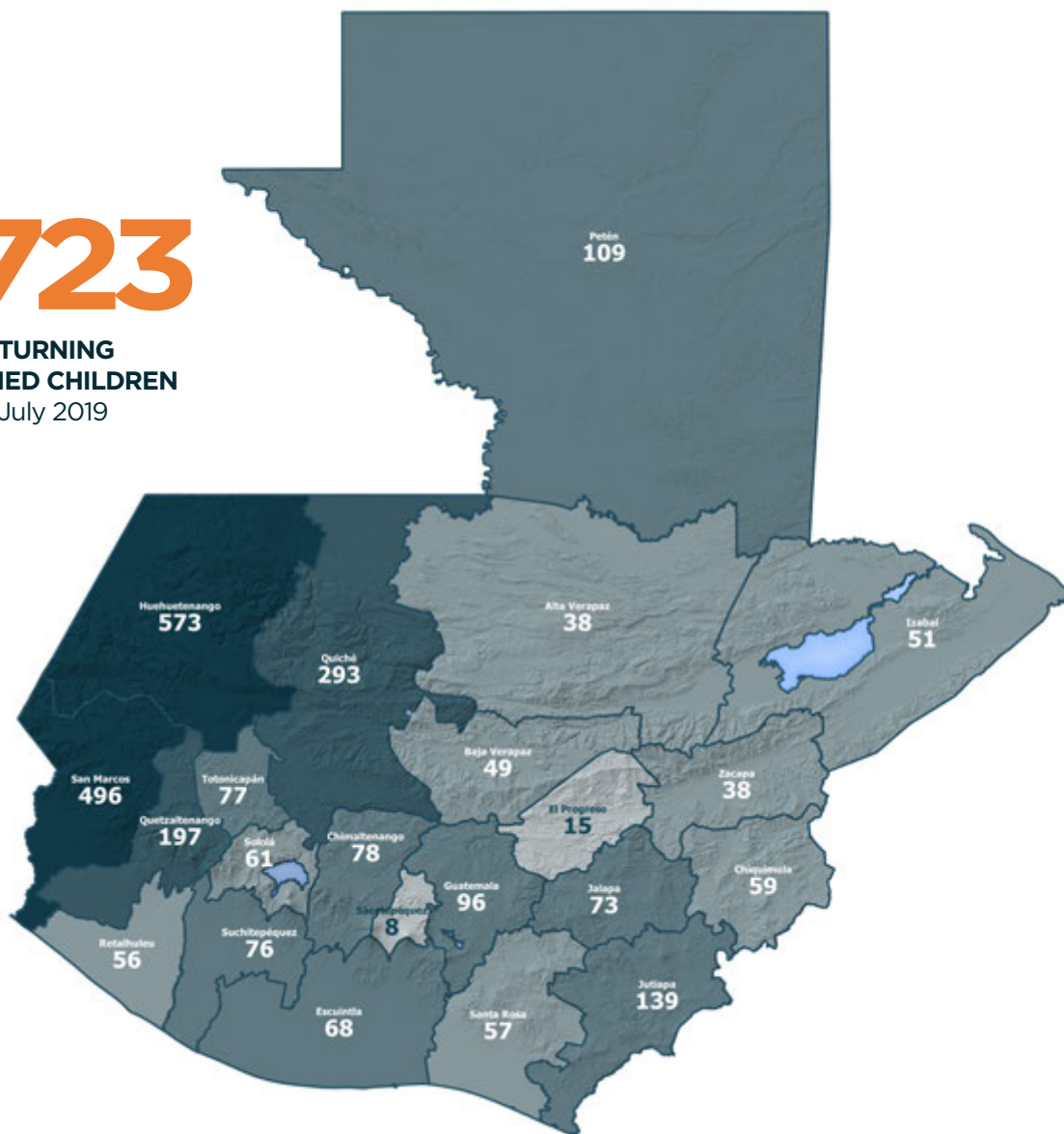

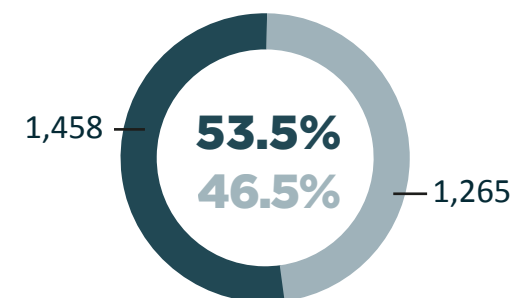
### RETURNING UNACCOMPANIED CHILDREN BY COUNTRY OF REPATRIATION

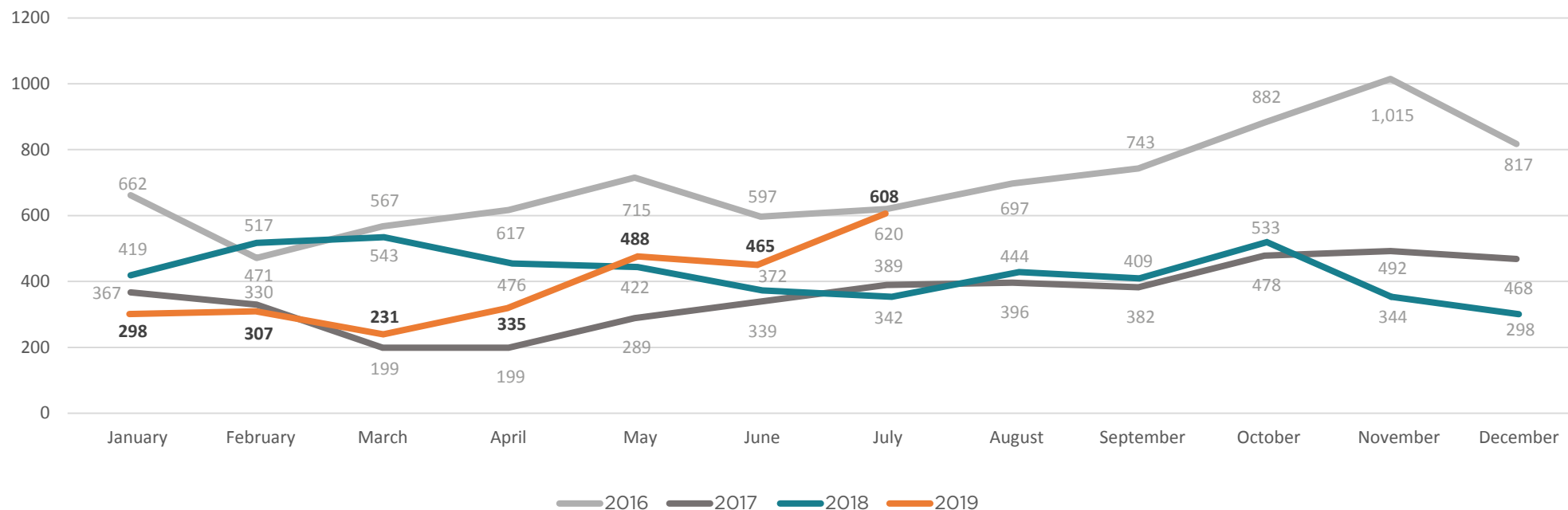
### UNACCOMPANIED CHILDREN RETURNING BY RECEPTION CENTER
